## VINEYARD

A west-facing vineyard located in the village of Elvillar, Rioja Alavesa, perched atop a hill at 2,100 feet (646 meters). A 2.9 ha parcel of white chalky limestone soil planted in 1967. We farm the land by horse and follow Biodynamic tenets.

## HARVEST AND PRODUCTION

Hand-harvested in 10 kg cases following a rigorous selection in the vineyard. Full clusters are fermented in concrete vats with indigenous yeasts. Following fermentation, the wine is pressed and matured in 500-liter French oak barrels for one year.

## TASTING NOTES

Freshness and perfume, wild flowers and berries, mild spices and a fine palate. A fruit forward wine, sappy and savory with muscular tannins.



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
